

INTRODUCING THE NEW MME FEATURE IN PORTAL

With the opioid crisis still prevalent, Carlisle is taking action to provide adequate information to the needed parties. MME, or Morphine Milligram Equivalent, is the listed amount of morphine equivalent to the strength of the opioid dose prescribed. The CDC recommends not exceeding 90 MME per day.*

Carlisle Connect now provides an easier, at-a-glance way to monitor a patient's MME intake.

Carlisle Connect now has a Daily MME listing for your claimants. This provides a quick glimpse of the total MME value from a claimant's medication.



Where is this in Portal?

The MME information can be accessed via the Patient Injury screen under Claims. The Current Daily MME calculates the value of MME of current prescriptions a patient is taking. This provides an easier glimpse of the MME value for all medications prescribed.
